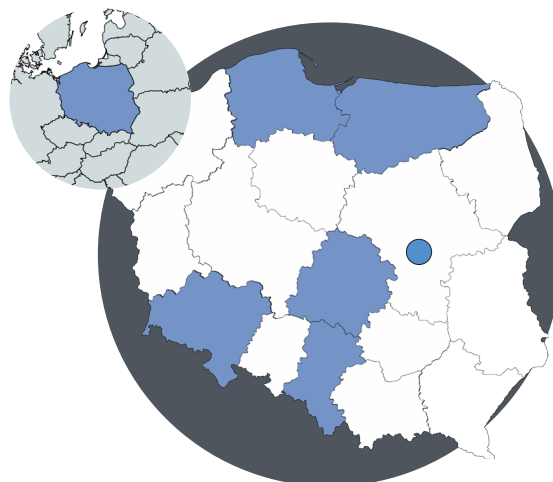

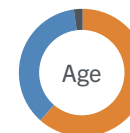

## Who we work with

In 2023, LWF Poland supported **107,825** (refugees) people.



- 60,868 adults (56%)
- 35,950 children (5-18) (33%)
- 11,007 children under 5 (11%)



- 176,589 women and girls (78%)
- 59,421 men and boys (22%)

# Our impact

Fundacja LWF w Polsce (LWF Poland) focuses on two programmatic areas: Protection and Social Cohesion and Quality Services. These areas are designed to address the immediate and long-term needs of affected communities, fostering integration and access to essential services. LWF Poland has implemented 4 projects, each tailored to cover these priorities as follows:



## QUALITY SERVICES

**4,788** beneficiaries received Multi-purpose Cash Assistance

**6,196** vouchers to access Medical, Winterization, Life essentials and Education services.

**612** assistive devices provided to People with Disabilities



## PROTECTION & SOCIAL COHESION

**21,173** individuals received Mental Health & Psychosocial Support

**23,856** children reached via Children Safe Spaces

**40,050** individuals assisted by Social Workers Support
