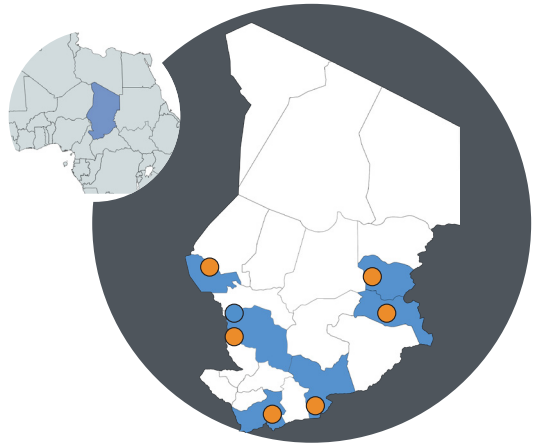
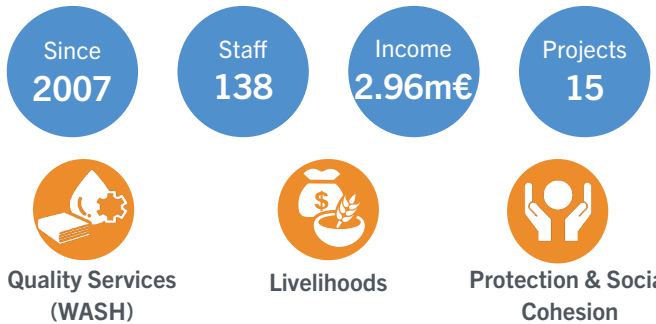




About us

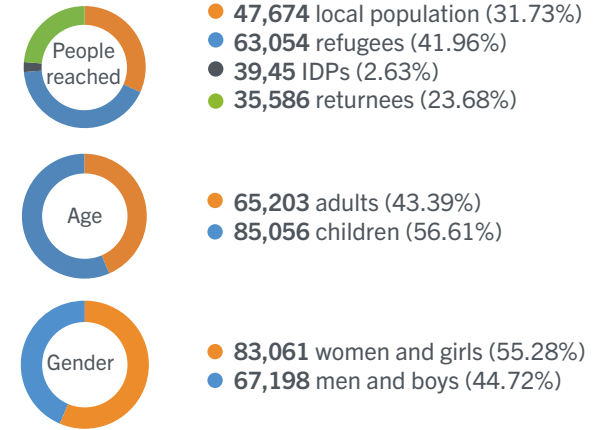

Who we work with

In 2023, LWF Chad supported **150,259** people.



Nadjoua Souleyman, 36, a mother of eight living in a polygamous household, and whose husband is not present, expresses her satisfaction after training on preparing Moringa leaves. She also benefits from an improved Banco hearth, which helps manage cooking energy.

“Before the training, many in our village used Moringa only to feed camels. Our village lacks water, and during dry periods, fresh vegetables become rare. Our meals are mostly limited to millet-based fofous and dried okra sauces. Thanks to LWF, we discovered the various uses of Moringa and Cassava leaves. Once we started consuming the vegetables, we discovered that our children experienced fewer stomach issues.”

Our impact

Across our programmatic areas, we act inclusively to provide responses that integrate protection and social cohesion, climate change adaptation, and resilient livelihoods. We also ensure that we provide quality services to create pathways for change and restore hope to the people we interact with, including key groups, so that they can rebuild their lives. Thus, in the short term, we save lives through emergency humanitarian actions and in the long term, we bring about meaningful change so that all people in need can lead fulfilling and resilient lives in a just and adequate environment.
