

Fundacja LWF w Polsce (LWF Poland) established in May 2022 by the Lutheran World Federation, is part of a global network of 149 Lutheran churches with over 77 million members. It provides non-discriminatory relief assistance to Ukrainian refugees and asylum-seekers guided by principles of humanity, neutrality, impartiality, and independence.





Who we work with

In 2023, LWF Poland supported **107,825** (refugees) people.

Our impact

Fundacja LWF w Polsce (LWF Poland) focuses on two programmatic areas: Protection and Social Cohesion and Quality Services. These areas are designed to address the immediate and long-term needs of affected communities, fostering integration and access to essential services. LWF Poland has implemented 4 projects, each tailored to cover these priorities as follows:







QUALITY SERVICES

4,788 beneficiaries received Multi-purpose Cash Assistance

6,196 vouchers to access Medical, Winterization, Life essentials and Education services.

612 assistive devices provided to People with Disabilities

21,173 individuals received Mental Health & Psychosocial Support
23,856 children reached via Children Safe Spaces
40,050 individuals assisted by Social
