His involvement with the KufrSoum Pomegranate Producers Association opened doors to an LWF-funded project focused on goat care and dairy production. With a strong foundation in rural farming and a collaborative spirit, Abdulhadi played a pivotal role in transforming the initiative into a thriving success, ensuring a stable income and paving the way for future expansion with his partners.

# **Our impact**

LWF Jordan is structured around three core programmatic areas: Livelihoods, Protection & Social Cohesion, and Quality Services. Additionally, the integration of persons with disabilities, gender justice, and climate justice are foundational principles that permeate all our intervention sectors.
