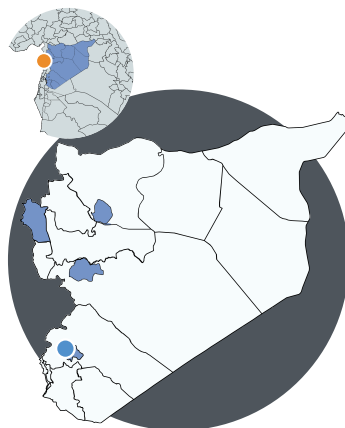

About us

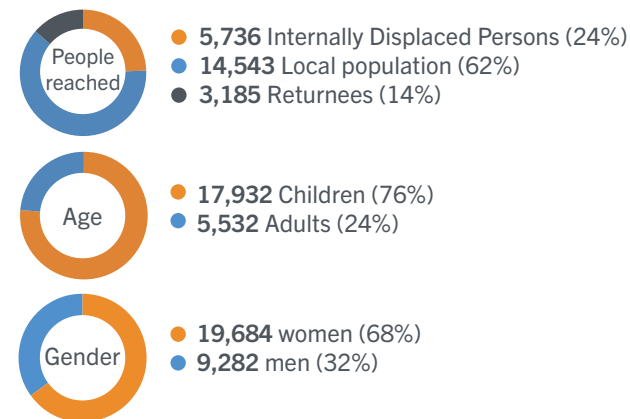

AI-Qadisiah School Community

“These children are like my own. Seeing the solar system installed felt like it was for my own home.”

For years, students in Aleppo's AI-Qadisiah School studied in darkness, after conflict left classrooms damaged and unlit. LWF and AI-Ta'alouf installed solar panels, transforming dim halls into bright, safe spaces. Teachers embraced innovative methods; children learned free from eye strain and fear. Parents finally felt secure sending their kids to school. Alongside, awareness sessions on bullying and GBV fostered a safer environment. Hope returned, lighting both classrooms and futures.

Our impact

Since 2012, LWF has supported Syrians by reducing vulnerability and strengthening resilience. After the 2023 earthquake, LWF swiftly aided Syria with protection & social cohesion, health, and shelter rehabilitation. Partnering with local partners and guided by “Do No Harm,” LWF integrates protection, social cohesion, and quality services across all work—covering Protection & Social Cohesion, Mental Health and Psychosocial Support (MHPSS), Capacity Building and Training, and Emergency Response including WASH, Shelter, NFI, aligned with the 2019-2024 Global Strategy.



QUALITY SERVICES

Total beneficiaries 17,464

- 18 schools powered by solar systems (≈250 students each)
- 1,000+ solar kits distributed to vulnerable households



PROTECTION & SOCIAL COHESION

Total beneficiaries 6,000

- 100 partner staff trained on protection
- 2,500 attended child protection & GBV sessions
